The International Congress on Logistics and SCM Systems is organized by The International Federation of Logistics & SCM Systems (IFLS) and The Asian Pacific Federation of Logistics & SCM Systems (APFLS). The 1st Congress was hosted by Waseda University in Tokyo, Japan, November 22-24, 2004, followed by the 2nd Congress hosted by The National Kaohsiung First University of Science and Technology in Kaohsiung, Taiwan, May 1-4 2006. The 3rd Congress was hosted by Kanagawa University in Yokohama, Japan, August 29-31, 2007, the 4th Congress by Asian Institute of Technology in Bangkok, Thailand, November 26-28, 2008, the 5th Congress by The Korean Society of Supply Chain Management(KSCM) in COEX, Seoul, Korea, June 3-5, 2009, and the 6th Congress by College of Management, National Kaohsiung University of Applied Sciences and co-organized by Association for Commercial Modernization in Kaohsiung, Taiwan, March 7-9, 2011.

Submission

Prospective authors should submit an abstract or full paper in English, outlining aims, content and conclusion as well as other contributions. The abstract or full paper should include the cover page with a title, topic areas, key words, author name(s), affiliation, mailing address, and the contact information of the corresponding author such as a mailing address, telephone and fax number. The final manuscript for the proceedings would be fine in the format of MS Word or Power Point slides. Submissions should be made electronically through e-mail icls2012@kscm.org.

Proceedings and Publication

All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. In addition, some selected papers after the conference will be invited for publication in the "International Journal of Logistics and SCM Systems" (The official journal of IFLS) and special issue of "Flexible Service and Manufacturing Journal" (SCI) after the conference. The best paper will be awarded during the conference.
